CLOTHING

- 10 pair socks
- 10 pair underwear
- 8-10 t-shirts
- 2 long-sleeved shirts
- 1-2 white t-shirts for tie dying
- 3 pair jeans/long pants/sweat pants
- 1 dressy outfit (casual, for dances)
- 5 pairs shorts
- 3 sweatshirts/sweaters
- 1 raintcoat/waterproof jacket
- 1 light jacket
- 1 sunhat/baseball hat
- 2-3 pairs pyjamas (1 light, 1 warm)
- 3 swimsuits (no string bikinis)
- 1 blue t-shirt (2nd session only)
- 1 green t-shirt (2nd session only)

BEDDING/LINENS

- 1 light-weight sleeping bag or blanket
- sheets: 2 bottom, 2 top (single or twin)
- 1 pillow
- 4 large towels
- 2 washcloths

FOOTWEAR
